

Figure S3. *Padh1*-expressed OsTIR1 is more effective than the F-box proteins used in the Kanke system for disrupting the functions of *cdc45* and *orc2*.

Spot assay showed that when combined with *cdc45-IAA17* or *orc2-IAA17*, the *Padh1-OsTIR1* cassette was more effective at causing NAA-dependent growth inhibition than the F-box-protein-expressing cassettes of the Kanke system.
